### Attitudes towards English Language Learning among EFL ...

The findings of investigating the secondary stage students' attitudes toward learning English as a foreign language and their achievements in reading comprehension indicated that the respondents have positive attitudes toward learning English (Momani, 2009). Also, there was a strong correlation between the students' attitudes toward learning English and their performance in reading comprehension.

### EFL students' attitudes toward learning English language ...

Attitudes towards language learning should also be taken into consideration. The purpose of this study is to explore students' attitudes towards learning English in terms of gender, grade level and department variables. Data were collected through a Likert-type scale from a total of 1275 students enrolled at Firat University, Turkey.

### An evaluation of students' attitudes toward English ...

attitudes towards learning English on their academic achievement was thoroughly studied depending on a sample that consisted of 112 English major students who ranged from freshmen to seniors with different grade point averages (GPA). The study findings demonstrated that the students in general have positive attitudes towards learning English.
