As we reopen gatherings, most churches will want to launch the nursery and preschool programming that takes place during Sunday gatherings first.

Infant and toddler nurseries should be located near the sanctuary, restrooms, and fire exits. Nurseries should be attractive, safe, welcoming spaces.

Church members use the facilities as a place to leave children during work hours or during services where they can trust the staff and feel there will be a proper spiritual side to the experience the children have there.

The following health guidelines are widely held as standard procedure for daycare facilities, and are intended to aid parents and nursery workers in determining whether or not a child can be accepted in the nursery for care. Temperature - A temperature of 100 degrees or below with NO OTHER SYMPTOMS is acceptable.

Every volunteer or paid worker in the church nursery should first go through a thorough background check which includes the known sexual predator and child abuser lists. Windows in the doors - Having windows installed in the doors to all the rooms in the nursery prevents anyone from being able to hide inappropriate behavior behind a closed door.

Nursery Guidelines No one should be in the nursery except the nursery workers and the children being brought to the nursery for care. Ages for the nursery are birth through 3 years of age and should not be in the nursery without a nursery worker present. The nursery is not to be used as a playroom for older children at any time.
