How to Cite a Website - APA, MLA & Harvard - Mendeley

Label the page Works Cited (do not italicize the words Works Cited or put them in quotation marks) and center the words Works Cited at the top of the page. Only the title should be centered. The citation entries themselves should be aligned with the left margin. Double space all citations, but do not skip spaces between entries.

If you cite from different volumes of a multivolume work, always include the volume number followed by a colon. Put a space after the colon, then provide the page number(s). (If you only cite from one volume, provide only the page number in parentheses.)

The APA reference page is a separate page at the end of your paper where all sources you cited in the main text are listed. The references are sorted alphabetically, double spaced, and formatted using a hanging indent of ½ inch. Use "References" as page heading and include a running head with your paper title and page number.

Whether you cite the source within the text of the sentence (a signal phrase) or in parentheses at the end of the line, a page number should be included for all direct quotes. Besides the page number, the citation should include the author's name and the publication date.

Use fp. and page numbers to designate where the chapter is found in the volume. Italicize the book title, then give the book editor' (s') name (s). Do not invert editor' (s)' name (s). Use initials instead of first and middle names for editor (s).

Insert page numbers justified to the right-hand side of the APA format paper (do not put p. or pg. in front of the page numbers). For all pages of the paper, including the APA format title page, include the "TITLE OF YOUR PAPER" justified to the left in capital letters (i.e., the running head).

MLA (Modern Language Association) style is most commonly used to write papers and cite sources within the liberal arts and humanities. Basic book citation format The APA in-text citation for a book includes the author's last name, the year, and (if relevant) a page number. In the reference list, start with the author's last name and initials, followed by the year. The book title is written in sentence case (only capitalize the first word and any proper nouns).

How to cite a book in APA - Scribbr

Include a page header (also known as the "running head") at the top of every page. For a professional paper, this includes your paper title and the page number. For a student paper, this only includes the page number. To create a page header/running head, insert page numbers flush right. Then type "TITLE OF YOUR PAPER" in the header flush left using all capital letters.

Cite web pages in text as you would any other source, using the author and date if known. Keep in mind that the author may be an organization rather than a person. For sources with no author, use the title in place of an author. For sources with no date use n.d. (for no date) in place of the year: (Smith, n.d.).

In-text Citation - APA Quick Citation Guide - Library ...

An APA in-text citation includes only three items: the last name (s) of the author (s), the year the source was published, and sometimes the page or location of the information. References include more information such as the name of the author (s), the year the source was published, the full title of the source, and the URL or page range.
