Leith Hill is the highest summit of the Greensand Ridge, approximately 6.7 km (4 mi) south west of Dorking, Surrey and 40.5 km (30 mi) south west of central London.It reaches 294 m (965 ft) above sea level, and is the second highest point in south-east England, after Walbury Hill in south west Berkshire, (which is 297 m (974 ft) high). Leith Hill is the highest ground for 79 km (49 mi).
