Depth: At least 2 meters (6.6 feet) Temperature: 25-28 degrees Celsius (77-82 degrees Fahrenheit) Sometimes pools are designed to accommodate both dimensions, with a length of 50 meters and a width of 25 yards. In these instances, a mobile bulkhead often helps set the pool up for long course or short course.

How Big is an Olympic-Size Pool?

Recreational swimming pool users, particularly children, don't require great depth and it is adequate to provide a sloped floor which goes from a minimum depth of 36 inches to a maximum of 4 or 5 feet. A purely recreational pool also does not need to be any particular shape, so you can pick a shape to complement your lot.

Planning a Swimming Pool's Size and Depth

The minimum space for a table is the playing area plus the length of a cue (58") plus about 6 inches for the back swing, more for comfort, on each side. This gives: "Seven foot" tables vary in size. Work down from the 8' dimensions. "8+" is an "oversized" 8-foot table.

B.C. Guidelines for Pool Design, is intended to help designers, operators and regulators interpret the regulation, with respect to pool design. The guidelines represent generally accepted standards of safe practices. Depending on the type of pool and the use to which it is put, higher design standards may be necessary.

B.C. Guidelines for Pool Design

Sloped entries must extend to depth of 24 inches minimum to 30 inches maximum below stationary water level to ensure buoyancy. At least one landing must be located 24 inches to 30 inches maximum below stationary water level. In wading pools, sloped entry and landings must extend to deepest part of pool.

ADA Final Guidelines for Swimming Pools, Wading Pools and Spas

For example, the shallow end of the pool is 40 feet x 20 feet = 800 square feet; 800 / 15 = 53 bathers. The deep end is 40 feet x 80 feet = 3200 square feet. There is one diving board, so you deduct 300 square feet, arriving at 2900 square feet; 2900 / 20 = 145 bathers.
