The tabernacle (mishkan), first mentioned in the in Exodus 25, was the portable sanctuary that the Israelites carried with them in the wilderness. Mishkan comes from the Hebrew root meaning “to dwell”; the tabernacle was considered to be the earthly dwelling place of God.

The Tabernacle was a portable tent with a wooden framework to give it stability. The entire sanctuary consisted of three parts: An outer court enclosed by curtains supported on pillars. It was oblong in shape and the entrance was on the east side.
