As provided for in Corporations Code §7224(c), a resignation takes effect upon written notice to the board and does not need approval by fellow directors to be effective. Future Date. If your resigning director had made her resignation effective at a future date, she could have withdrawn it. From your question, it appears the director did not qualify her resignation nor did she withdraw it.

Withdrawal of Resignation - Davis-Stirling

If the employee changes his/her mind and wishes to withdraw the resignation, it is no longer a unilateral matter, because the employer must agree to the withdrawal. Generally speaking, an employee does not have the right to unilaterally withdraw his/her resignation once handed in.

Allowing the withdrawal of a director's resignation would be inconsistent with this locus of membership power. Also, allowing a withdrawal would raise the issue of the director's status during the period between the time of his resignation and the time that the resignation is withdrawn.

Withdrawal of members (1) Subject to the provisions of the Act, these rules and the bye-laws of a co-operative society, a member may withdraw his membership by submitting a resignation in writing to the society and the committee shall dispose off his resignation within forty
